Getting Acquainted with the McCoy's! (Continued from 1st Quarter Newsletter)

-What types of ministry has King's Kids Unlimited, Inc. done? We have ministered in four states in a variety of settings from churches, campgrounds, grange fairs, camp meetings, and tent revivals. We taught at a Bible training center in Kenya and did outreaches to children in the area and we also did outreaches and teacher seminars in El Salvador. For the past three years our focus has shifted to doing more teaching and ministry on the Father's Love in our home.

-When did you receive the revelation of the Father's Love? How has it affected you? Our first encounter with the Father's Love was through Jack Frost's ministry seven years ago. It totally changed our lives and or marriage. It opened our eyes to all the wounds and pains that we did not know were in our hearts and how that was affecting us. Sue experienced release from a performance orientation and started freely receiving Abba's love. Receiving His Love allowed Rick to walk free from a 43-year addiction to pornography, masturbation, voyeurism, and fantasy lust. Freedom from these addictions and receiving healing from our past wounds totally revolutionized our marriage and personal life. We have a new compassion for all the people who are trying to deal with their past wounds and pains in all the wrong ways. Our passion is to help others experience the freedom and joy we have found in our Father's Love.

-What is Your Vision for KKU in the future? We already have plans to take the Father's Love message to and train teachers in children's ministry in Zambia this year and Nigeria in 2010. We are believing for the finances and open doors to also take this vitally- important message to other nations as Abba leads us. In addition, we want to continue training teachers, ministering to children, and helping people individually and corporately receive the Father's Love here in the U.S.

Are You Blessing or Cursing?

Power in Our Words

Our words are powerful. The Bible tells us in James 3:10 that "out of the same mouth proceeds blessing and cursing." You have the capability to speak words that will bring both blessings on yourself and others, or that can bring a curse. Whenever you speak the Word of God, you are activating the blessing of the Lord in your life or the lives of others. You can also pray or speak a blessing over someone that is based upon the Word and His promises. Every father should speak a blessing over each one of his children before they leave home. When you speak positive encouraging words about someone, you are releasing blessings into their lives.

Bless or Curse?

However, the same mouth that speaks blessings can also release

curses if you are speaking negative things or putting someone else down. You can speak curse words that release bad things to happen in your own life or the lives of others. These don't just have to be the coarse words spoken in the bars, but words spoken out of anger, despair, frustration, hate, or an attempt to control or manipulate can activate a curse and cause bad things to happen in your life or others. A good example occurred in my family. My mother always told everyone during the years I grew up that every year all three of her boys were sure to get strep throat, and we did! Since I left home, I've never had strep throat again.

Power in Our Actions

Although your words can be powerful, your actions can be just as effective in releasing blessings or curses. The Hebrew verb "to bless" is barak. Barak also can mean "to kneel." We kneel when we come into the presence of someone of great authority such as a king or queen. It is an expression of honor or giving great weight to the person before whom we kneel. The Hebrew verb "to honor" is *kabad*. It can also mean to give great weight to or highly esteem. If we look at 1 Sam. 2:30, we can get a clearer understanding of this. Our heavenly Father said, "...for those who honor (kabad) me, I will honor (kabad), and those who despise (bazah) me, shall be lightly esteemed (galal). The Hebrew word bazah means "to disesteem, despise" and the Hebrew word galal means "to curse, lightly esteem, make small of, trifling, vile." An even stronger verb "to curse" is arar which means to bitterly curse. In Gen. 12:3 our heavenly Father said to Abraham, "I will bless (barak) those who bless (barak) you, and I will curse (arar) him who



curses (galal) you. Our Lord bitterly cursed those who lightly esteemed Abraham (and He will do the same for Abraham's seed -us!).

If you put these Hebrew words together, you can begin to see how your actions, as well as your words, can also bring blessings or curses. Those things in your life that you give great weight to and pay much attention to will be blessed, increase, and flourish, but those things which you ignore, lightly esteem, pay little attention to will be cursed and decrease or die. If we look at the life of Jesus, we can see this in action. Take for example the fig tree. Jesus didn't say, "I curse you fig tree." He just said that no one would eat fruit from it again. It was the same as a curse, and the fig tree died. On another day, Jesus took what seemed of little importance and blessed it before the Lord. When He did, the five loaves and two fishes began to multiply as His disciples began to give them to the people, and they fed over 5,000 people.

Another example that comes to mind is when Moses sent the 12 spies to spy out the Promised Land. Ten of the spies brought back an evil report. They spoke 9 negative descriptions of the land and only one positive (that it flowed with milk and honey). They gave great weight to the negative things and their negativity increased in the eyes and minds of the people of Israel. Those 10 spies with the evil report decreased and died without receiving the promise. Only two spies, Joshua and Caleb, gave a good report. Their seven (the number of perfection) comments about the land were all positive and they made light of the giants ("they are bread for us"). In the end, it was only Joshua and Caleb that received their inheritance and the blessing in the Promised Land.

Which Reality Will You Choose?

There are two kinds of realities in life, negative and positive. Whichever one you give more weight to

will be blessed and increase in your life. If you don't acknowledge the blessings in your life, you are cursing them and they will decrease. You must be thankful in everything, but you should be giving your attention to the positive things in your life so that they will increase. If you talk about what the devil is doing in your life, how hard life is, how we are constantly fighting and binding the devil all the time, you are honoring the devil and all his evil will increase in your life. You don't need to rebuke the devil all the time.

The highest form of resistance is to ignore the devil and make light of him. When you do, the devil will be cursed and decrease. You need to let Father arise, give Him all the glory, and honor His power so that He will be blessed and increase in your life! Let God arise and let His enemies will be scattered. (Ps. 68:1)

Another Hebrew word for "pay attention or take heed to" is shemer. It can also mean to preserve, protect, retain, or keep. "The Lord bless (barak) you and keep (shemer) you." (Num. 6:24) Whatever you pay attention to, you preserve and protect in our life. If you are paying attention to what the devil is doing in your life, you are preserving and keeping it. This is why positive speaking, thinking, and imaging are so important in your life. You cannot look on two things at the same time, positive and negative. What you focus your atten-



tion on will be blessed and increase in your life, both good and bad.

Weight To God's Word!

When you give great weight to God's Word, you are blessing your Father! Those things in you that you give thanks to Father for will be blessed and multiply. When you pay attention to what someone else is saying or doing, you give great weight to them and bless them. When you focus on the positive things another person is doing, you bless the positive traits in them, and they will increase and multiply! But if you focus on another's negative traits and problems, you are giving great weight to and blessing the negative, which will grow in their life. This principle works in vour life too!

When you focus on the symptoms on your body, what the doctor says, what other people are saying that are negative about your condition, what bad news you read about your condition in books or on the internet, you are honoring and giving weight to the symptoms and they will remain and increase. Instead, you must focus on what the Word says and the promises of health and wholeness. You must give thanks for the finished work of the cross and that Jesus already took your sicknesses and infirmities on his own body. "...by whose stripes you were healed." (1 Pet. 2:24)

Abraham had to ignore his age and keep his focus on what God had promised him. Every time he looked up into the stars, he would remind himself of God's promise for a son. He gave no attention to his age and ended up with not only one son, but seven more children through a second wife! Sarah, Abraham's wife, was so beautiful at age 90 that King Abimelech wanted to taker her as one of his wives in his harem! When you talk about getting older, the things that you can't do any more, and all the symptom of old age coming on you, you are cursing your body and honoring old age. Ignore your age and live young!



Families...bless or curse?

You would never dream of cursing your children, but when you ignore them, make light of what they are saying, make fun of them, or embarrass them in front of others, you are putting a curse on them. However, when you get down on our knee (barak) and look them in the eye, you honor them and they are blessed. You bless your children when you pay attention to them when they are speaking to you, spend quality time with them, and acknowledge what they are doing that is good. If you honor and give weight to what your kids are saying, then they will be more open to honor and give weight to what you are saying.

Few of us would even consider speaking a curse to or over our wife, but every time you ignore her, give light weight to what she says, or do not honor her, you are cursing her and she will whither and decrease like a plant that has not been taken care of or watered. If you don't acknowledge the blessings and good qualities in your wife, you are cursing her and those good qualities will decrease and die. The same is true with wives towards their husbands.

On the other hand, if you honor your wife before others, give heed to her words, complement her on her appearance, help her around the house, and speak kind words to her. you bless your wife and the good qualities in her will increase. The secret to the "Proverbs 31 Woman" is found in verse 28 of that proverb, "Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her." (emphasis added) In 1 Pet. 3:7-8 husbands are instructed to give honor to their wife, and both are told to be of one mind, compassionate, tenderhearted, loving, courteous, blessing one another that they both might be blessed. When we bless our wife, it brings out her beauty and true femininity. It is a wise husband who brings out the virtuous qualities in his wife!

Steps of Blessings

Here are some steps that you can take to help you walk in His blessings, for yourself and those around you:

1. God's promises are invisible to the natural eye. Spiritual truths are more real than what we see in the visible natural world. So don't focus on or give weight to the visible temporal world and what is happening around you. Instead, focus on the invisible eternal world that is revealed through the truths in His Word and give honor to what Father has already done for you.

2. Ignore what the devil is trying to do. Remember, Jesus slept in the boat during the storm.

3. Don't bless the evil and negative by speaking evil words that don't agree with His Word. Turn away from the nay-sayers, gossipers, and those who speak idle words.

4. Be more conscious of His power and presence than the symptoms on your body or needs in your life. Keep your eyes and thoughts focused on the positive.

5. Give honor to the gift in others who are coming to you, and you will draw the blessing out of them onto you.

6. Whatever you value will increase in your life and whatever you ignore will decrease. Accentuate the positive and eliminate the negative!

7. Don't speak about the negative circumstances and situations around you. Speak what the Word says about your situations.

8. Speak only words of life that edify, encourage, lift up, and bless your spouse, children, and others.

9. Spend quality time daily with your spouse, children and other important people in your life.

10. You need to consider Jesus and nothing else. Don't take your eyes off of Jesus!
