The Finished Work of the Cross

The last words we have recorded that Jesus spoke before He gave up His spirit were, "It is finished." **John 19:30** He had completed His mission here on the earth, trained those who would carry on His work, suffered the cruel punishment for our sins, took all our infirmities and pain, and went to hell to bring final victory over sin and death for us. The perfect work of the cross has continued to impact my thinking and life as I meditate on its significance. I have purposed in my heart to make it the last thing that I think about each night before I fall asleep and the first thing that I think about each morning as I wake up and begin my day. I'm sure that I will never reach the depth of understanding of what those last words of Jesus really mean for us. I would like to use the rest of this article to

share some of what the Father has revealed to me.

Health to All Our Flesh

Prov. 4:22 tells us that the Word is life and health to us and in **John 1:14** we are told that Jesus is the Word. Because of the fall of Adam, there is a curse on the land and in our natural "earthy" bodies. They are subject to sickness, disease, infirmities, aging, and death. Our natural bodies, like the whole earth, are subject to the law of entropy. This law says that everything is moving from a more complex state to a less complex one. The Father wants to remove the curse on the land through the revealing of the sons of God. **Rom. 8:19** Father provides a way for us to continually have our bodies be

renewed through the cross. We can reverse the effects of the curse by allowing Him to take our sicknesses, diseases, infirmities, etc. on the cross and replace them with new body parts and cells. In this way our bodies can be continually renewed like the eagles. **Ps. 103: 5** (Remember there is no time in the spirit and the Kingdom!)

Jesus is continually restoring our youth every time we take communion and see everything on the cross. **(Job 33: 24-25)** We rightly discern the Lord's body and the finished work of the cross **(1 Cor. 11: 28-29)** by believing that Jesus did fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah, taking our infirmities and sicknesses. **(Matt. 8: 17)** Just the opposite happens when we don't discern



the Lord's body; sicknesses come upon our body and we can die young. **1 Cor. 11: 30** Every day we must see every infirmity and sickness on Jesus on the cross and allow the Holy Spirit to make us alive again in our mortal flesh. **Rom. 8: 11** Father sent His Word (Jesus) to the cross and it healed us and provided a way for us to continually walk in youthful health! **Ps. 107:20** Symptoms cannot stay on our body; they just pass through us and onto the cross. The curse on the land may still be here, but the cross provides a continual way to keep its effects off of us. We must keep an image of the cross and Jesus' body with every infirmity on it before us all the time

You Are Righteous!

Through Jesus' obedience on the cross, we have been justified and made righteous by our faith in the finished work of the cross. **Rom. 3: 23-26** Jesus demonstrated His love for us that while we were yet sinners, He died for us. **Rom. 5:8** It was not anything that we did, but it was by grace that His righteousness was bestowed upon us as a gift. **Rom. 5:17** All we need to do is believe it for ourselves and walk in that righteousness by faith. Since the cross was a spiritual act of the Kingdom, it occurred outside of time and thus can be applied to us and our situation today and into the future. As far as the Father is concerned, it is a finished work and He remembers our sins no more. **Jer. 31: 34** Father is looking at us through the

finished work of the cross and sees us as righteous.

The shed blood of Jesus continues to cleanse us from all our sins and keeps us righteous. **Rev. 1:5** Because there is no time in the spirit, there is not a time that we are not in a state of righteousness. We should have no feelings of shame or guilt, and no time of being unrighteous because every sin we have committed as well as all we will ever commit have already been covered by the blood. Jesus does not have to go back onto the cross or sprinkle more blood on the altar each time we commit another sin. Our sins have been covered once and for all time. **Heb. 10:10** The Father has forgiven us of all our trespasses (past, present, and future). **Col. 2: 13** We just have to keep

walking in the light and allow His blood to cleanse us from all our sins.



I'm not saying that we will not sin again, nor does it give us the right to keep on sinning because our sins are already covered by the cross. When we realize how much the Father loves us and take our position as a son or daughter in His house, we will not want to displease Him or do anything that would hurt Him. His unmerited love and forgiveness

will compel us to do what is right and will bring glory and honor to our Father. When we walk after the Spirit, we will not walk after the flesh any more or fulfill its lusts. **Rom. 8: 2-8** Paul admonished us to "awake to righteousness and sin not." **1 Cor. 15:34** Keeping the law and doing something to earn the Father's acceptance and pleasure will only cause us to focus on sin and our failures to keep God's Word. Guilt, shame, self-condemnation, and unrighteousness will defeat our every effort to try and do it all right. If we keep going from righteousness to unrighteousness and back again, we will never have the confidence that we need to be victorious and believe that our prayers are being answered. Focusing on the finished work of the cross will make us righteous conscious and not sin conscious.

Prosperity Is Part of Our Inheritance

Because of the finished work of the cross, we are not only made righteous, but also we have been adopted as sons and daughters in His family. **Rom. 8: 14-16** Only sons have an inheritance! In addition, the New Covenant established through the shed blood of Jesus on the cross connects us to the Father in every way. There is nothing that the Father has that He does not want to give us. Because there is no time in the spirit, everything the Father has is available to us now. Through the cross and our faith in Jesus, we are also called "Abraham's seed" and entitled to the same inheri-



tance that Abraham had. Father told Abraham that He would bless him that he might be a blessing to others. **Gen. 12: 2** Father is making us great and pouring out His blessings on us in every area of our lives. Abraham wasn't just rich, the Bible says that he was very rich in silver and gold! **Gen. 13: 2**

Paul writes in **2 Cor. 8: 9** that Jesus was made poor (in heavenly standards!) that we might be made rich. The Greek word used for the word "rich" literally means in material goods. Jesus not only took our sins and sicknesses on the cross, but also took our poverty and lack. It has always been the desire of our heavenly Father that we both be in health and prosper. **3 John 2** Believing in the finished work of the cross puts us in the position to be good receivers of all that the Father has in store for us.

Greater Works Than Jesus

Jesus makes an awesome statement in **John 14: 12** when He told us that, because He was returning to the Father, we would be able to do even greater things than He did while He was here on the earth. I heard one person say that one of the greater works we can do is lead people to receiving Jesus as their Lord and Savior. I also believe that with modern technology, we can minister to people all over the world from a single place and see people experience the Father's love through healings, deliverances, salvations,

restored relationships, and all the gifts of the Spirit. There have been crusades where over a million people have heard the gospel at one time. The greatest outpourings of the Spirit and love of the Father are yet to come as people turn to Jesus as their only hope for the future.

By Jesus leaving the earth He allowed the Holy Spirit to come and teach and comfort us, tell us of things to come, and tell us what the Father is saying. **John 14: 16-17, 26, 15: 26, 16: 7** It is the Holy Spirit that bears witness with our spirit that we are the sons of God. **Rom. 8: 16** (When good things happen to us, the Holy Spirit whispers into our ear, "Isn't that just like your Dad to do that for you!) The Holy Spirit also guides us into all truth and gives us understanding and wisdom from the scriptures.

It's All About Receiving

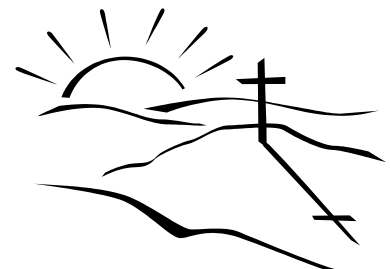
Jesus' finished work on the cross is for everyone for all times. We don't need to ask Father to save someone or give them salvation because Jesus already took care of that on the cross. **1 Pet 2: 24** What we need to pray is that person will receive the salvation Jesus has already provided for them and pray against Satan trying to blind their eyes from seeing and their ears from hearing this good news. **2 Cor. 4: 4** We don't have to pray that Father will heal someone or bring health back into their bodies. He already healed our bodies on the cross.

We need to pray that they will receive what is already theirs through the finished work of the cross. We don't have to pray for Father to give us finances and take care of all our needs because Jesus already did that on the cross. He became poor that we might become rich.

2 Cor. 8: 9 We just need to believe and receive what has already been given us through the cross.

The finished work of the cross gives us the confidence to stand on His Word, pray boldly, and believe that we receive when we pray. **Mark 11: 23-24, 1 John 5: 14-15.**

I hope that these truths will begin to impact your life like they have mine. As I have begun to walk more and more in a position of Sonship, I have experienced more healings in my body and when symptoms come onto my body they do not stay very long. I am experiencing more favor in little things like parking spaces and shopping experiences. We are completely out of debt and are giving more away than we have ever done before. And I give all of the glory to my heavenly Father who is pouring out His love on me. Father is no respecter of persons and He will do the same for you!
